- Write occasional in-depth research reports articulating credit quality opinions and outlooks at a security, issuer, and sector level.
- Review portfolios of credits on an ad-hoc basis.

The analyst will report to the municipal strategist. He or she will work closely with the municipal trading desk and also have the opportunity to work with other sector strategists, economists, and portfolio managers to identify market opportunities and help develop our broader fixed income strategy.

Qualifications include 5-7 years of municipal credit experience, with experience at a buy-side firm or in a trading environment a plus. Strong communication skills and the ability to multitask are also needed. Bachelor's degree required, MBA preferred.
